

## **Stool Electrolyte and Osmolality Collection Instructions**

Do not send formed stool, the test <u>will not</u> be performed. Submit only watery stool samples. Consult your health care provider if your stools are not a watery consistency.

Do NOT use laxatives prior to the collection of the stool specimens.

## Instructions

- 1. Place a collection hat over the toilet bowl. Lower the seat and pass the stool into the hat.
- 2. Transfer the stool specimen into the container provided by the laboratory or your health care provider.
- 3. Label the container with **your full legal name**, date of birth, collection date and time.
- 4. Return the specimen to a Sanford Patient Service Center or Sanford laboratory as soon as possible.
- 5. If you are unable to return the specimen promptly, the specimen can be refrigerated for up to 48 hours.
